OVERVIEW

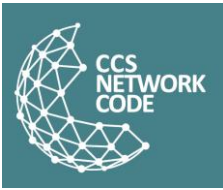
This Modification aims to correct a series of housekeeping changes within Annexure C of the Code. As this Modification proposes amendments to Annexure C, the Specific Provisions apply as per CCS Network Code B44.

STATUS

On 12/11/2025 the Modification Panel¹ unanimously agreed that CCS005 could be determined Fast-Track Self-Governance (in accordance with Section B 28.2 (c)). The Modification Panel unanimously voted to **APPROVE** the Modification for implementation and provided detail about the rationale for this decision against the Objectives of this code (see Section 6).

This is a Final Modification Report which has been updated with the discussion and views of the Modification Panel.

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1 BACKGROUND

SUMMARY

This Modification seeks to make changes to Annexure C Part 1 following the identification of errors, minor amendments or the need for a new defined term that does not pose a material change to the legal text, such as correcting typographical errors, clarifying headings and improving formatting.

ISSUE

Minor errors have been identified in Annexure C Part 1 which could cause confusion or uncertainty.

PROPOSED SOLUTION

This Modification seeks to make several changes to the following areas of Code, following identification of errors or minor amendments. The Secretary has provided rationale for the proposed changes in the table below.

Suggested amendment	Rationale
Annexure C Clause 1.1: Unclear definitions amended formatting to ensure clarity.	
Annexure C Clauses 2 and 3: Unclear headings – headings amended to ensure clarity.	
Annexure C, Clause 4 (one instance), 14.4 (two instances) and 27 (one instance): Missing space – space added.	The errors could result in confusion and uncertainty. The changes being made will help to add clarity to the legal text and in places plug gaps that have been identified through further scrutiny.
Annexure C, Section 6: Clause 6.3 labelled incorrectly as 6.1, creating a duplicate – amended to 6.3	
Annexure C, Part 1, Clauses 14.2, 14.7, 15.4 and 19.7: References to C02 where the 2 is not subscript – amended to C02	
Annexure C, Section 24: Incorrect grammatical use of 'sort' - amended to 'sought'.

The implementation of these minor housekeeping changes will ensure that the Code remains as correct and relevant as possible. The changes are being proposed as a way of ensuring that the Code remains as relevant and complete as possible. This will promote the efficiency of the administration of the Code.

2 IMPACT ASSESSMENT

PARTY IMPACT ASSESSMENT

No impacted parties have been identified for this modification. As these are non-material impacts, the Proposer does not believe the changes will have impacts on Users or T&SCo systems or procedures. The User agreed that the changes would not have an impact at the pre-panel modification discussion at the Workgroup on 7th November 2025.

PROGRAMME FOR WORKS

No programme for works has been proposed for this modification.



3 IMPLEMENTATION DATE AND APPROACH

The outcome of the Modification should be targeted to be incorporated into this Network Code in an ad hoc release on the 8 December 2025.

4 SELF-GOVERNANCE

The Proposer believed that this Modification was a housekeeping change and therefore met the criteria to be determined a Fast-Track Self-Governance modification.

The changes being proposed have been collated via an industry owned issues register that has been viewed by the Panel at intervals. The proposed changes are also, by nature, not material and therefore do not seek to change the intention of the Code, rather to either add clarification or reduce unnecessary ambiguity.

5 MODIFICATION PANEL DISCUSSION (NOVEMBER 2025)

This modification was discussed at the Modification Panel meeting on 12/11/2025.

Section A of the CCS Network Code states that Annexure B, Annexure C and Annexure E fall under "Specific Provisions" and are specific to each individual T&S Network. Given this, the Secretary must convene a Panel comprising the T&SCo owning and operating the network and each User holding a Connection Agreement relating to the T&S Network as voting members, with the Secretary of State and the Regulator as non-voting Members. The voting rights of the panel are outlined in paragraph 44.3 (c).

Voting members¹ unanimously agreed that the Modification Proposal met the criteria for Fast-Track Self-Governance and unanimously voted to approve CCS005 for implementation.
